When you think of an outreach or mission, does your mind immediately go to far flung places? Here in metro-Manila, millions of people find themselves economically stranded, isolated from family and resources found in the provinces they hail from.



For this reason, healthcare professionals from the Greenhills Christian Fellowship (GCF) in Makati provide a free medical and dental clinic to their neighbourhood. Once a year, invitations are sent out to hundreds of domestic workers, local security guards and of course homeless people. This is critical care for many.
